PLEASE NOTE :- To fish Snipe Lake, Tuscany Lake or Daughters Lake there are certain tackle requirements in force. Please call or look at our website at beaverfarmfishery.co.uk. This month the catch report is a little bit light, as of this time every year when the clocks change a lot of anglers will put their fishing gear away until the spring. We have also had some heavy downpours and the first few frosts of the year which hasn't helped anglers decide to get on the bank.

SNIPE LAKE This lake hasn't been fished as much as usual this month but there have been a few carp banked. The biggest this month fell to **Danny Williams** when he banked a common of 25-02, a few of the new stockies have been banked to 16lb which includes **Harry Philpot** landing his **PB** at exactly 16lb and after a few years chasing a target fish, I managed to bank the linear mirror called Stumpy Tail at a healthy 20lb.

TUSCANY LAKE Typically at this time of year the catfish anglers tend to get their pike rods out so like Snipe Lake, Tuscany Lake has been a little quiet on the angler front. We have however had a few cats grace anglers nets, after **Danny Williams** had the 25-02 common on Snipe he moved over and banked a small one at 12lb, John Lamport and his mate **Steve Deeley** had a couple out to 26-08, **Vic Collier** also had a couple out at 24-01 and 26-15 while **Jeff Betts** had a great month when he banked 11 in four visits including cats at 24, 27-08, 28, 29, 30, two at 34, 40 and a 49, most of his sessions were just afternoons so well done Jeff.

JEFF'S LAKE As usual this lake is producing for the pleasure angler who is after quantity over size. Lots of F1's and some decent bream have been banked. The Jeff's Lake Open results this month were:- 1st place – **Trevor Pavitt** with 42lb, 2nd place – **Martin Charnock** with 40lb 4oz and 3rd place – **Bob Beale** with 31lb 12oz. Well done to all that took part in a very wet and very windy day.

MOAT POND This little pond has not been fished quite as much this month. It has however produced a few carp for the anglers that have fished it up to the standard size of about 6lb.

DAUGHTERS LAKE is now back open after being shut whilst we dealt with the algae issue over the last couple of months. Ben and I are pleased to announce some great news. After the heartbreak of losing some of the stock in Daughters Lake in the summer due to the crazy weather which caused an algae bloom, we are very pleased to welcome some new stock for the lake. We have taken delivery of some stunning new mirrors to add to the existing stock. With the loss of some fish in the summer we have decided to keep the stocking of Daughters Lake to approx 90 fish, this is to minimise any future oxygenation issues. The stock in Daughters Lake will now consist of mirrors and commons to mid doubles and grass carp to low 20's. The fish that we have stocked in 2017 and now in 2018 have very progressive growth rates so it is exciting times ahead. Here's to a wet and much cooler summer in 2019!

EDEN POND as you know is mainly a tench pond and at this time of year they tend to be a bit harder to catch which in turn means that the tench anglers have not bothered. Roach and silvers have been caught.

MAZE LAKE has produced a few fish for day anglers and a couple of examples of this are when **Tony Sawkins** did a little session and banked 5 bream to 4lb and a lovely linear mirror of 5-12 and **Clive Whittington** continued catching on Maze when he banked 3 carp to 8lb and a new p.b of 9-14.

MAJORS LAKE is still low on the water level front but if this rain continues it won't be long before it is back to normal. As usual the carp have at this time of the year slowed up a bit but **Terry Edwards** had a result when he banked a mirror at 18-02. The pike fishing has been ok with lots of pike out from 6-7lb to low doubles. The bigger pike haven't made an appearance as yet but hopefully they will as the water temperature gets colder.
