Even though the weather has cooled down a bit, it has still been pretty hot. The water is still crystal clear and the fishing has been consistently good throughout. The hot sun is not ideal for fly fishing but if you use small weighted flies to get a bit deeper. Lots of fish have come out on buzzers and dries, but it's mainly been goldhead nymphs that are working best. Hopefully things will cool down a bit more over the coming weeks and this should help the fishing to be even better. The current catch rate is still around the 90% mark most weeks. A few daddy longlegs have started to appear already, a sure sign that Autumn is on it's way. Let's hope we get some much needed rain (but just at night!). The annual September Singles competition was held last month. Twenty five fishermen attended this year to battle it out for the trophy. The object is to catch the heaviest 3-fish bag, with the rule that you must move to a different lake when you've caught a fish. **Paddy Hill** was the winner this year, with 3 fish weighing in at 17lb. **Kev Hunt** was second with **Keith Potter** in third.
